NOTICE FOR std 12 Students (A.Y. 2025-26) + candidates who appeared for the Feb. March 2026 HSC Board Exam

Contents of this notice are based on Circular dated April 30, 2026 issued by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE) regarding Online declaration of results of the above mentioned Examination. According to this circular, MSBSHSE will be declaring results of the Higher Secondary Certificate (Class 12) examination conducted in Feb- March 2026 Online at **1 PM on Saturday, May 02, 2026**. Subject-wise compiled marks of all the students who have appeared for the examination will be available from the above websites and a copy (print out) of this information can be obtained. Similarly, the **Digilocker** app has a facility to store digital marksheets.

Other information related to the Feb.-March 2026 HSC Result

1. After the online declaration of results, students who appeared for the Higher Secondary Certificate (Class 12) Examination may apply online to the concerned Divisional Board for verification of marks, photocopies of answer sheets, or revaluation for any specific compulsory subject (excluding grade subjects). The application must be submitted by the student directly via the Board's official website <https://mahahsscboard.in> The necessary terms, conditions, and instructions are provided on the website.

Applications for verification of marks and photocopies of answer sheets can be submitted online from **Sunday May 03, 2026 to Sunday, May 17, 2026**. The prescribed fees can be paid online through Debit Card, Credit Card, UPI, or Net Banking.

2. For applying online for revaluation of answer sheets of the Higher Secondary Certificate (Class 12) Examination held in February–March 2026, it is first mandatory to obtain a photocopy of the answer sheet. From the date of receipt of the photocopy, students must apply online to the Mumbai Divisional Board within five working days (before May 17, 2026), following the prescribed revaluation procedure and paying the required fee in the prescribed format. Students seeking revaluation should contact the Mumbai Divisional Board for further information.

As per MSBSHSE State Board Circular dated April 30, 2026, students who have appeared for the February–March 2026 Higher Secondary Certificate (Class 12) Examination with all subjects and have passed will be provided three subsequent opportunities under the Class Improvement Scheme (CIS) to improve their grades/marks. These opportunities will be available in June–July 2026, Feb.–March 2027 and June–July 2027. Such students are required to re-appear in all subjects including HPE and EVS.
4. Students who wish to appear for the June-July 2026 supplementary HSC Board Examination as Repeaters (regular or CIS), are required to check the Junior College website www.rdnational.net regularly after receiving their Physical Mark Sheet. for a related notice on the same which will carry details of the procedure of Application for the same.
