- Who were studying in Std 11 during A.Y. 2023-24.
- Whose Std 11 result was declared as FAIL by the College during May/June 2024.
- Who have taken Leaving Certificate marked Std 11 Fail and left this College.

Such candidates are required to carry out the following :-

- Visit the website <https://mahahsscmarks.in/private-candidate-login> anytime from fill up and submit HSC Form No 17 online from this website along with online payment. Obtain a print-out of the application form submitted online, Undertaking as well as copy of online fee payment receipt made to the Board during submission of application.
- Submit the documents enlisted below to College, Second Floor Cabin no 235 outside Vice-Principal's Office on any working day from August 14, 2024 to September 27, 2024 between 10:30 AM to 1;30 PM (***See Note below***).
- **Documents to be submitted in College**
 - Print out of original HSC form no 17 from above mentioned website + one copy self-attested
 - Undertaking Performa attached form No. 2 & Form No. B Two Copies Xerox self-attested
 - Copy of online fee payment receipt made to the Board during submission of online application of Form No 17
 - Original Std. 10 Marksheet + Passing Certificate + Two self-attested photocopies of each
 - 10th std School Leaving Certificate - two Photocopies attested
 - 11th Std (AY 2023-24) Original Marksheet showing result "FAIL" & **College Leaving Certificate** + Two Copies Xerox self-attested
 - Aadhaar card - two photocopies self-attested
 - *Eligibility Certificate of Std 11 + Two self-attested photocopies in case the applicant has passed Std 10 from any Board other than Maharashtra State SSC Board.*

Note:

1] The Board permits Colleges submit fixed and limited number of Applications. Therefore, only valid applications will be accepted by the College on First-Come-First-Serve basis. Once the limit is reached, the College will be unable to receive any further application in this regard, irrespective of any last date of acceptance. Therefore, interested candidates are required to submit their applications at the earliest.

The College will not be responsible in any way if any willing applicant is unable to submit their application after the College has received the maximum permissible number of applications, irrespective of date of submission.
